

The Calling Cup

The Calling Cup is a consecrated chalice that goes from home to home and is used as a focal point of prayer to pray for **vocations** to the priesthood and consecrated life.

Here is how it works:

1. Families, individuals, and couples can sign up to host *The Calling Cup* in their homes in three ways:
 - a. on the board in the gathering space
 - b. Contact Andrea Komorowski 574-551-4645 or akomorowski07@gmail.com
 - c. or sign up on the Google Document found at https://docs.google.com/document/d/1CRv0TTwAH60mFnVX6jqzhGjXHwfIgsAsiF3FO_TH1AE/edit?usp=sharing to host *The Calling Cup* in your home for a week.
2. At mass, walk up behind the people taking up the gifts at the offertory. After the gifts are handed to Father Phil, he will give you *The Calling Cup* to take with you back to your seat.
3. Display *The Calling Cup* in a prominent place in your home where it will be seen often throughout the day. Each day for a week, during prayer time (morning, bedtime, or meals), the hosts pray for an increase and perseverance of vocations. A prayer journal also travels with *The Calling Cup*. Each week the family, individual, or couple that has the cup enters a thought, prayer, or scripture verse in the journal.
4. At the end of the week return *The Calling Cup* to church before the 5 p.m. Saturday mass. Place it up by the altar.
